- Meeting the foreign language requirement of VNU-HCM and of UEL (except for foreign students in accordance with the Regulation on the work of foreigners studying in Vietnam enacted together with Decision No. 33 / 1999 / QD-BGD & DT dated 25th August 1999 of the Minister of Education and Training);
- Obtaining national defense education and physical education certificates;
- At the time of graduation, student isn't in charge of criminal prosecution or disciplinary action with the suspension.

12) Brief description of courses

1. Name of course: Introduction to Civil Law

Credit: 03

Prerequisites: Students must finish Introduction to State and Law course.

Brief description of course content: This course majorly discusses these main topics:

- Subjects of regulation and methods of regulation in Vietnamese Civil Law; the system of Vietnamese Civil Law; differences between Civil Law and other laws; Legal science in Civil Law; Basic principles governing Civil Law; principles of applying law, practices and equalities into civil relations regulation.

- Definition, nature and elements of Civil legal regulations; Vietnamese civil relations; differences between civil relations and other legal relations.
- Legal status of entities in civil relations, legal relations between non-person entities and their founder; establishment, internal organization and restructuring of non-person entities.
- Conditions for a legal representative, scope of representation, rights and obligations of a legal representative and a principal.
- Conditions for effective civil transactions, handling invalid civil transactions.
- Methods for calculating time-limits and limitation periods.

This course will majorly discuss in depth of 06 main chapters:

- Chapter 01: Overview of Vietnamese Civil Law;
- Chapter 02: Civil Legal Regulations and Civil Relations;
- Chapter 03: Legal status of Entities in Civil Relations;
- Chapter 04: Representation Provisions;
- Chapter 05: Civil Transactions;
- Chapter 06: Time-limits and Limitation Periods;

2. Name of course: Environmental Protection Law

Credit: 03

Prerequisites: Students must finish: Introduction to state and law; Introduction to Civil Law; Property Law; Tort Law.

Brief description of course content: This course will majorly discuss in depth of 07 main chapters:

- Chapter 01: Overview of Law on Environmental Protection;
- Chapter 02: Laws on Controlling of Environmental Pollution, Emergencies and Degradation;
- Chapter 03: Law on Conservation of Biodiversity;
- Chapter 04: Law on Strategic Environmental Assessment and Planning for Environmental Protection;
- Chapter 05: Law on Controlling of Natural Resources;
- Chapter 06: Law on Resolving Environmental Disputes;
- Chapter 07: Compliance with the International Treaty on Environmental Protection;

3. Name of course: Law on Notary, Certification and Bailiff

Credit: 03

Prerequisites: Students must finish all required courses of Civil Law Program.

Brief description of course content: This course comprises of 3 chapters relating to notarization, certification and process serving under legal provisions.

This course will majorly discuss in depth of 3 main chapters:

- Chapter 01: Law on Notarization;
- Chapter 02: Law on Certification;
- Chapter 03: Law on Process Serving;

4. Name of course: Skills for Resolving Civil Cases

Credit: 03

Prerequisites: Students must finish general stage of Civil Law Program.

Brief description of course content: This course equips the student a more comprehensive understanding of applying law, reading case laws and commenting on judgement. Therefore, students are more capable of realizing and considering whether it is legal.

This course will majorly discuss in depth of 6 main chapters:

- Chapter 01: Commentary on Civil Judgement;
- Chapter 02: Commentary on Marriage And Family Judgement;
- Chapter 03: Commentary on Labor Judgement;
- Chapter 04: Commentary on Contract Judgement;
- Chapter 05: Commentary on Land Judgement;
- Chapter 06: Commentary on Inheritance Judgement;

5. Name of course: Marriage and Family Law

Credit: 02

Brief description of course content: This course is aimed to equip the student a basic and general knowledge about Marriage and Family Law, which includes overview and basic principles of the law; marriage and family relations; the history of Marriage and Family Law; Getting married; Relationship between husband and wife; Relationship between parents and children; Support obligations; Termination of marriage; Marriage and family relation involving foreign elements.

This course will majorly discuss in depth of 06 main Chapters:

- Chapter 01: Definition and Basic Principles of the Marriage and Family Law;
- Chapter 02: Marriage and Illegal Marriage;
- Chapter 03: Personal Relations in Family;

- Chapter 04: Identification of Parents and Children;
- Chapter 05: Termination of Marriage;
- Chapter 06: Support Obligation.

6. Name of course: Labor Law

Credit: 03

Prerequisites: Students must finish: Introduction to the State and Law; Introduction to Civil Law; Property Law; Tort Law; Civil Procedure Law.

Brief description of course content: This course is aimed to bring you the basic and general knowledge of:

- Subjects of Regulation and Methods of Regulation
- Contents of Industrial Relations
- Subjects about Employment and Apprenticeship
- Provisions and Requirements of Labor Recruitment and Labor Contract
- Provisions and Knowledge of Social Insurance
- Issues of Compensation for Damage; Differences between Compensation for Damage in Industrial Relations and in Civil Relations.

This course will majorly discuss in depth of 11 main chapters:

- Chapter 01: Definition of Labor Law;
- Chapter 02: Legally Industrial Relations;
